At Your Weakest Moment ...

... that's when Satan will tempt you to sin. Our adversary is no fool. He's not going to waste time and effort by working against your strengths. He will attack you when you are the weakest and where you are most vulnerable.

Here's an example: Someone has had harsh words to say about you. They have assumed the worst, impugned your motives, jumped to false conclusions, spread rumor and innuendo about you. How will you react? You are angry, hurt, insulted, disgusted. The strong temptation is to strike back, to get even, to put this person "in his place". But, you must not submit to the temptation. God's word says, "Never pay back evil for evil to anyone... Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Rom. 12:17,21). It's hard to follow this instruction at the moment, because you are weak and vulnerable. But this course of action is best – the Lord says so, and our own experience bears this out.

During such times of weakness and vulnerability, we should pray as David did, "Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips. Do not incline my heart to any evil thing, to practice deeds of wickedness with men who do iniquity; and do not let me eat of their delicacies" (Ps. 141:3,4).

We've been warned that Satan has many "devices" (2 Cor. 2:11). Chief among these is his ability to detect our weaknesses and attack us there. Please realize that you must work hardest during your weakest moments, because that is when Satan is at work against you.

Why People Do Not Understand the Bible

-Part 2 of 4

WHY ARE PEOPLE IGNORANT OF THE BIBLE?

Some Do Not Study It. John Quincy Adams read four or five chapters of the Bible every morning immediately after rising. He said, "It seems to me the most suitable manner of beginning the day." Yet only 26 percent of Americans said they read their Bible on a regular basis (four or more times a week). Of Bible readers, 57 percent only read their Bibles four times a year or less. Fifty-seven percent of those ages 18-28 read their Bibles less than three times a year, if at all. Only twelve percent read the Bible every day, and among these, the average time was only nine minutes a day. Is it any wonder that thirty-one percent said, "The Bible is too difficult to understand?"

It is impossible to have a saving, strengthening Scripture knowledge without regular study (<u>Acts 17:11; 2 Timothy 2:15</u>). We do not expect to learn math, English, science, history or literature without cracking a book. The Bible is no different.

We should study the Bible because it gives

- Light in a darkening world (Psalm 119:130).
- Understanding in a wondering world (Psalm 119:130).
- Knowledge in a confusing world (<u>Proverbs 2:6</u>).
- Approval in a rejecting world (2 Timothy 2:15).
- Stability in a floundering world (James 1:3-6).

Religious people often do not study Scripture, relying instead on the traditions of their parents and the views of their preachers. Many could not point to the Bible as authority for what they believe (cf. Colossians 3:17). Christ's words are hauntingly real in our generation, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures" (Matthew 22:29). Some spend more time with Swindoll or Lucado than they do Peter and Paul. As strange as it sounds, we need to put the Bible back into our religious curriculum. (to be continued)
