During a battle in which Yahweh permitted the Philistines to defeat his people, the Philistines captured the ark of the covenant. However, life wasn't enjoyable for the Philistines while they had the ark: mice ravaged the land and deadly tumors broke out in the people's groin (the connection with mice and deadly tumors in the groin has led many modern scholars to believe Yahweh inflicted the Philistines with the bubonic plague). Since "the hand of God was very heavy" on the Philistines (1 Sam 5:11), they naturally wanted to rid themselves of the ark.

They put the ark on a cart pulled by two milk cows which had never before been yoked, and the cows made their way in a straight line to Israel at Beth-shemesh. The people of Beth-shemesh celebrated the return of the ark with worship before Yahweh. However, some of the men got a bright idea and "looked upon the ark of the LORD" (1 Sam 6:19), and 70 of the men died. The Hebrew for "looked upon" means to stare or to gloat, certainly an act of irreverence.

As the people mourned for their lost family and neighbors, the men of Beth-shemesh said, "Who is able to stand before the LORD, this holy God?" (1 Sam 6:20). The men of the town understood immediately that one doesn't simply play with God. The ark of the covenant was no ordinary object; the box had come from the mind of God and had been built to Yahweh's specifications, contained sacred objects to remind the Israelites of God's great power, and was the meeting place between the Lord and the high priest. Yet, some men disregarded God's holiness and paid a great price.

We dare not disregard God's holiness, or we, too, shall pay a high price. When we assemble in God's presence, we're not playing; we have, instead, come into the presence of a holy and awesome God to worship. What we're doing is serious business: the most serious business in which anyone can engage. Minds and hearts need to be centered on God. We must center our own minds and hearts on God and help our neighbors do so by not creating distractions.

God is holy, and he must be regarded as holy by those who would draw near to him. Let us assemble in God's presence with holiness and righteousness that the Lord God may be honored.
