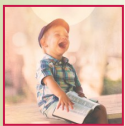

## Unity

God's word is truth (John 17:17) and when we are all grounded in the truth of God's word unity will be the result (Ephesians 4:1-15).

Truth does not cause division because truth is constant. Division comes when someone blows the winds of false doctrine and topples Christians who are not grounded in truth. They are "carried about by every wind of doctrine" because they have no roots. False teachers use trickery, cunning craftiness, and deceit to cause division in the church (read the passage above).

There is much division in the religious world today. Why? There are two reasons: First, false teachers come into a church and draw away disciples after themselves (Acts 20:29-30). They are more interested in promoting themselves than in teaching God's truth. Second, Christians who are not grounded in the truth follow the false teachers. Their ears have been tickled by the cunning craftiness of the false teacher and they are drawn away after their own lust (2 Timothy 4:2-4).

False teachers and itching ears always result in divisions and "new churches" spring up. But truth always brings unity among those who hunger and thirst after righteousness (Matthew 5:6).

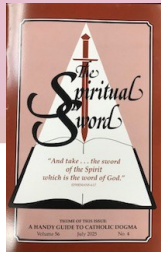

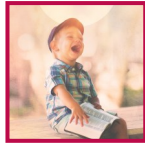

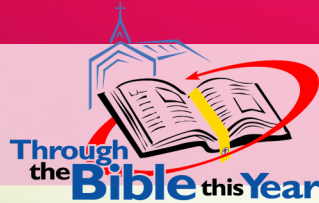

**Christ Is the Center, Focus & Key House to House**

Let us not forget the reason the Bible was written and preserved: "that you may know that you have eternal life" (I John 5:13). Christ is the center, focus, and key to the inspiration and interpretation of the Bible. This is why the books of the Old and New Testaments fit together so well into one cohesive and comprehensive whole. Taken together, they present the progressive unfolding, revelation, and communication of Christ.

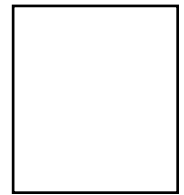
1. The Law (Genesis-Deuteronomy) prepares the ground or base on which the moral system of Christ rests. It is the beginning or first principles of the system of truth. Christ is the ultimate foundation of all that is right (I Corinthians 3:11).
2. The History section (Joshua-Ester) shows the preparation for Christ. History, from an inerrant biblical perspective, holds true the necessity of righteousness and faith (2 Timothy 3:16).
3. Poetry (Job-Song of Solomon) express an aspiration for Christ the Savior. Seeing that Scripture is nothing less than the words of our very Creator, it is no wonder that throughout the centuries men and women have been astonished by it. David said, "The law of the Lord is perfect" (Psalm 19:7).
4. Prophecy (Isiah-Malachi) proclaims an expectation of Christ. The Bible is the account of redemption, how God rescues men from sin and from death.
5. The Gospel Records (Matthew-John) relate the historical manifestation of Christ. They are true accounts of the work and the act of Christ the Son of God (John 20:30-31).
6. Acts relates the propagation of the gospel of Christ. It portrays the resurrected Christ in His ascension, by the Spirit, through the disciples, for the producing of the church-the kingdom of God.
7. The Epistles (Romans-Jude) give the interpretation of Christ. The epistles answer questions asked by the church or address problems within the church.
8. Revelation describes the consummation of all things in Christ. The second coming of Christ marks the time when the church goes home for eternity.

How is it that every part of the Bible, in spite of its great diversity, can contribute to its overarching theme of redemption and its central figure, the Christ? How? Because it is from God! - Mark Posey

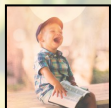
