Isaac: A Man of Peace

"It's just not fair!" We all have had times in our lives when this thought crossed our minds. Someone commits an injustice to us or to our loved ones, and we don't like it. The natural instinct is to strike back, to get even, to fight for our rights. The Bible, both through command and through godly example, shows us there is a better way.

In the arid land of southern Palestine, nothing is more precious than water. Without water, no herds or crops can live. Without water, no life can exist

After the death of Abraham, God blessed Isaac abundantly. The Philistines were jealous of Isaac's prosperity and instigated a conflict with him over water rights. Sometimes they filled Isaac's wells with earth, and other times they argued with him over the ownership of the wells. Isaac had a clear right to the wells he dug, as well as to the wells that had belonged to his father. Over and again, Isaac gave up these rights to avoid conflict with his neighbors. He chose a way of peace.

Centuries later God, speaking through Moses, would command the Israelites not to covet (Exodus 20:17). The Philistines suffered from a spiritual problem of envy. Isaac chose not to let their problem become his.

The Bible teaches the rightness of self-defense, both in protecting your person and in protecting your property. However, the Bible also shows that the better course to follow is to forgo our rights and to follow the way of peace. Isaac followed in the faith of his father, trusting God to provide. God blessed Isaac just as He blessed Abraham. "And he...dug another well, and they did not guarrel over it." (Genesis 26:22)

Gospel of Christ?

The theme of all the New Testament is the gospel of Jesus Christ. Practically every page provides information on the topic. In its simplest terms, the gospel of Jesus is the "good news" concerning Him. In a day when there is so little good news, it is important to spread the good news of Jesus.


The gospel message is that although man is a sinner, deserving of death, God loved mankind enough to provide salvation. Paul warned that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23), and "the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). Comfort comes, however, in knowing that "the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23). Christians are "justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus" (Romans 3:24). The amazing grace of God is truly good news.

At the gospel's heart is Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. As Peter preached the first gospel sermon on Pentecost, he spoke of "Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst" (Acts 2:22). Although He was put to death, death could not hold Him: "This Jesus God has raised up" (Acts 2:32). "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ" (Acts 2:36). The people were pricked in their heart, and said, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" (Acts 2:37). Peter told them how to accept the good news: "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38). The gospel is for "all who are afar off" (Acts 2:39). The church would include the Gentiles as well as the Jews.

Faith moved many to obey: "Those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them" (Acts 2:41). The church grew rapidly as many were added to the church (Acts 2:47). Christ commands: "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen" (Matthew 28:19–20). —Bob Prichard
