

Soul-Saving Sunday

October 19—Soul-Saving Sunday—is rapidly approaching, and there is much work to do.

Pray. Pray for the courage to invite your family, friends, and neighbors (cf. Acts 4:29). Pray that collective sharing of our faith "may become effective" (Phile 6).

Identify. You need to identify whom you will invite to Soul-Saving Sunday. Feel free to invite a friend who worships at another congregation of God's people, but that isn't the point. Identify folks who are lost—whether they are caught up in denominational error or don't go anywhere (the "unchurched" as they're often called). Identify at least five friends whom you can encourage to attend.

Invite. It's not enough to identify whom you will invite; you need to invite lost souls to Soul-Saving Sunday. Pick up some postcards in the front door. Put them in people's hands and look people in the eye and say, "I'd really love to have you worship with me that day." Stick them in the mail. Text or email the information. Make a phone call. Whatever your preferred method is *do* it!

Encourage. Being rejected is no fun. Not at all. Encourage your brethren to fight another day. Remind your brethren why we're in this fight. And pick up and carry on.

Remind. Remind those you invite how much it would mean for them to come worship with you on Soul-Saving Sunday. Whatever you do, don't let people forget the day.

Pray. Yeah, I know I've already mentioned prayer, but let's bathe Soul-Saving Sunday in prayer—let's, in other words, make prayer the first and last thing we do. Pray that people come to Jesus. Paul wrote of his fellow Jews, "Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved" (Rom 10:1). Pray for those who come on Soul-Saving Sunday. Pray that the word will be planted in their hearts. Pray that the seed of the word will take root and bring forth an abundant harvest.

That abundant harvest is what Soul-Saving Sunday is all about. Sure, we'll have a potluck, fellowship, and an enjoyable day, but none of that is the <u>why</u>. The <u>why</u> is really simple: To seek and save the lost.

Let's get to work!



Why Scripture Matters

Jesus said to them. "Is this not the reason you are mistaken, that you do not understand the Scriptures or the power of God?" (Mark 12:24)

Jesus regarded the Scripture as the measure of God's revealed truth. Jesus regarded every passage and even every letter as holy and authoritative. The Lord Jesus said, "For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall; pass from the Law until all is accomplished. Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever keeps and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven."


What was true for the Jews is just as true for Christians under the new covenant found in the New Testament. We cannot dismiss what God says about any matter. The Lord Jesus said, "Not everyone" who says to Me. 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter" (Matthew 7:21). Scripture matters because that is where we turn to find the will of the Father.

The truth that leads to eternal life (John 6:68-69) are in Scripture. This is why it is urgent and essential to know what the Lord and His apostles have taught in Scripture. Yes, salvation is at stake (Matthew 7:22-27). Scripture matters because salvation matters.


