

#### Stand In Awe

"Wherefore, receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us have grace, whereby we may offer service well pleasing to God with reverence and awe" (Heb. 12:28 ASV).

The right side of the doorpost to many Jewish homes bears a little case with the word shaddai, "Almighty," inscribed there upon. The case houses two paragraphs from Deuteronomy: Deut. 6:4-9 and Deut. 11:13-21. Such serves to remind the occupants and guests of the house of their responsibility to love and obey God as well as teach their children to do the same. The Jews have a reverence (though not according to knowledge-cf. Romans 10:1-3) for God. It is said that the name translated Jehovah is so sacred to the Jew that they refer to God as "the one whose name cannot be pronounced.

It is the responsibility of all men today to possess and manifest a reverence for the Almighty. In the words of the Psalmist, "God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be held in reverence of all them that are about Him" (Psalms 89:7).

Three times the word awe can be found in the book of Psalms. A casual scrutiny of these verses will provide three reasons why man should revere God. There is the: (1) Compassion of God (Psalms 4:4); (2) Creative power of God (Psalms 33:8); and (3) Communication, the word of God (Psalms 119:161).

Webster defines *reverence* as "a feeling or attitude of deep respect, love, and awe.. Such should flow from the heart of every man toward the august Almighty. "This is the end of the matter; all hath been heard: fear God, and keep his commands; for this is the whole duty of man" (Eccl. 12:13 ASV).

### What Is the Gospel of Christ?

The theme of all the New Testament is the gospel of Jesus Christ. Practically every page provides information on the topic. In its simplest terms, the gospel of Jesus is the "good news" concerning Him. In a day when there is so little good news, it is important to spread the good news of Jesus.

The gospel message is that although man is a sinner, deserving of death, God loved mankind enough to provide salvation. Paul warned that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23), and "the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). Comfort comes, however, in knowing that "the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23). Christians are "justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus" (Romans 3:24). The amazing grace of God is truly good news.


At the gospel's heart is Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. As Peter preached the first gospel sermon on Pentecost, he spoke of "Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst" (Acts 2:22). Although He was put to death, death could not hold Him: "This Jesus God has raised up" (Acts 2:32). "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ" (Acts 2:36). The people were pricked in their heart, and said, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" (Acts 2:37). Peter told them how to accept the good news: "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38). The gospel is for "all who are afar off" (Acts 2:39). The church would include the Gentiles as well as the Jews.

Faith moved many to obey: "Those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them" (Acts 2:41). The church grew rapidly as many were added to the church (Acts 2:47).

Christ commands: "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen" (Matthew 28:19–20). —Bob Prichard
