

## **Ten Things You Can Do for Soul-Saving Sunday**

- **1. Pray.** "The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working" (Js 5:16).
- **2. Invite.** "Go out to the highways and hedges and compel people to come in, that my house may be filled" (Lk 14:23).
- **3. Be here.** Do not be "neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near" (Heb 10:25).
- **4. Speak to our guests** "Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad" (Prov 12:25).
- **5. Prepare food.** Seven disciples had fished all night, and Jesus had started breakfast for them: "When they got out on land, they saw a charcoal fire in place, with fish laid out on it, and bread" (Jn 21:9).
- **6. Stay and eat.** "And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people" (Act 2:46-47).
- **7. Dream big.** "In hope [Abraham] believed against hope, that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been told" (Rom 4:18).
- **8. Be an encourager, not a Debbie Downer.** "A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in a setting of silver" (Prov 25:11).
- 9. Be an example to our guests. Some may not understand where to find texts in Scripture or whether or not they should take the Lord's Supper and the like, but you can model right behavior. "Set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity" (1 Tim 4:12).
- 10. **Sing.** Church growth research has demonstrated that singing is a large determiner in guests retention, so sing big. "Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise" (Js 5:13).

2 Thess 1


# Why must you know your Bible?

- To have everlasting life (John 17:3). With regards to the words of Jesus, the Bible is the only source of the perfect, saving knowledge of God and Christ.
- 2. **To know the greatest book ever written.** The Bible is the greatest book because God is the author. There were 40 writers but one author. "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God" (2 Timothy 3:16).
- 3. To know who you are. The Bible tells us our origin, purpose, and destiny (Genesis 1:26–27; 2:7).
- 4. **To be saved from sin.** The Bible answers the world's greatest question, "What must I do to be saved?" The gospel is the power of God unto salvation (Romans 1:16).
- 5. **To identify the church of the Lord and know its importance.** Christ has one body (the church, Ephesians 4:4) and Christ is the head of the body (Ephesians 1:22–23).
- 6. To find the Christian way of life, worship, and service. The inspired word teaches us that "denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age" (Titus 2:12).
- 7. To reach the highest goal: "The prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:14). —Frank Dunn
